





TO ALL MINERS, OUTDOOR RECREATIONALISTS, RANCHERS AND HUNTERS.

If you haven't heard about mining districts, you need to. It is the only SOLUTION in the United States that will open up mining, open up closed roads and may open up areas for grazing, places to ride ATV'S, allow humans to enjoy the outdoors and the ability to open up land for hunting.

The Mining Districts and the Mining Law are the only law's still on the books that can do this. MMAC has presented this to the Senate, to the House, to 4 Committee's and 2 DC think tanks and most agree, this is the only SOLUTION presented in the present political environment that can work. MMAC has presented this to BLM (Regional) for a model Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that if successful, can be the model for all mining districts across the United States. MMAC has already met with the State of California BLM Director to create a state-wide MOU. MMAC currently has Draft Bill's and an Amendments in for road access to stop closing and to reopen roads under the National Defense Authorization Act (Federal Public Land Road and Trail Access for War Readiness Materials) and another Bill that is the only solution that will save mining in the United states of America (The Minerals and Mining Regulatory Reform Act- A Clear Path respecting Mining Rights).

MMAC IS THE ONLY MINERS ORGANIZATION THAT HAS REAL SOLUTIONS

Why is this good for mining, recreation, hunting and ranching? California for an example: Obama signed an executive order closing more land and roads from humans. Mining, Recreation/off-roaders just lost 10's of thousands of roads for riding and using. This is the same for areas all across the United States. The only way to stop this and immediately reverse it OR NOT TO EVEN ALLOW IT TO HAPPEN is MINING DISTRICTS UNDER MMAC!

IT IS TIME TO STOP BEING VICTIMS ON A DEFENSE GAME AND CHANGING THE GAME FOR GOOD. BECOME OFFENSIVE PLAYERS WINNING THE GAME.

HERE'S THE PLAN:

All outdoorsman must ban together with miners who know about The Power of the Mining Districts. (mmacusa.org under Forms, Miners Rights, The Power of Mining Districts) The only United States of America recognized group for this is the Minerals and Mining Advisory Council (MMAC).

Are there other groups that will say they can do the same? Yes, but have they? NO! When they had a chance before MMAC did they? NO!

They have no solutions just complaints. MACC has solutions!

Make your financial and physical support towards MMAC.

Steps to play the game and win offensively;

Consult your MMAC Administrator for your MMAC Administrative District to make sure you are doing things right.

- A. If you are or are not a miner you must partner up with a miner that is connected to MMAC.
- B. Next for miner or non-miner you must find the Mining District(s) that you would be a part of.

- C. Miners put up a mining district sign showing activity. (On the mmacusa.org web-site is a sample of the mining district sign posting.) Directions where to put signage is also on the site.
- D. See mmacusa.org and go under Mining Districts to see the rest of the directions.

Step up to the plate and lets fight offensively and WIN. Defense is only one part of the game.

TO IMMEDIATELY STOP NEW LAND DESIGNATIONS DO THE FOLLOWING **TODAY!**

- "INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR MINING DISTRICT SIGN POSTING"
 - (Check and see, some counties may require sign permit.)
 - (a) Put your signage at entrances to districts TODAY. (See attached samples)
 - (b) Take a picture of you putting signs and holding a newspaper.
 - (c) GPS signage for future maps.
 - (d) Cement in deep with a pole or post that will hold up to nature.
 - (e) Attach sign that will hold up to nature.
 - (f) Put tar or water seal on back of sign to detour sign theft.
 - (g) Post in local paper that mining district is active, restaffed and give a simple letter to your local BLM or Forestry stating, "Your mining district is active and a Federal (Public Land) Stakeholder".
 - (h) Send a copy of the pictures to the agency that is closing the land.

OPTIONAL:

- (i) If you are prepared to sue an agency that is materially interfering with your mining, you may become an offensive player with a, "Direct and Constructive Notice". Only do this if you are prepared to fight and to take them to court.)
- (j) You just WON as long as you are prepared to fight!
- 2. Call the ICMJ, Prospecting and Mining Journal (831) 479-1500 the official United States notice publication and post an advertisement for candidates to become the new board of directors (BOD) for that mining district. Try to find your mining district by-laws first. If you cannot find them then vote in at least 3-5 BOD's if possible. (ICMJ will pass info to MMAC to post on mmacusa.org web-site. If you already have a legal mining district, send an email to MMAC so they can list it.) Consult your MMAC Administrator for your MMAC Administrative District to make sure you are doing things right.
- 3. Claim holders of that district can vote in BOD's. <u>Only claim holders can vote.</u> Remember there are a lot of rules and regulations depending on that mining district by-law. If you do not know them email or call MMAC. Consult your MMAC Administrator for your MMAC Administrative District to make sure you are doing things right.
