This Miner, Mining District, MMAC marriage is to show unification, national consistency and a constituency to federal, state and local agencies. Without this the miner and mining districts are on their own to fight federal, state and local obstacles that <u>will</u> come along, including new state laws, closures, land designations etc.. Being a separate mining district or miner, on his own, as we all know, does not and has not worked in any state. Also without this marriage of MMAC and Miner, the miner and mining district shall not be federally recognized as one large constituency with unified national consistency.

State maps with MMAC assisted mining district overlays will be turned in to Washington DC Committees at their request, which will be part of the national repository. This will be reflected at the federal and state government levels, which would be giving the MMAC Assisted Mining Districts and mining claims in those mining districts a chance to be pulled out of new and old land designations like Areas of Critical Environmental Concerns (ACEC's), Wildlife Management Areas (WMA's), National Landscape Conservation Systems (NLCS's), Wilderness areas, Monuments and new state laws.

With MMAC's known National Consistency between mining districts a national Memorandum of Understanding(s) (MOU's) with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) or the United States Forest Service (USFS), will be a strong possibility along as well as passage of the MMAC Bills and Amendments pending in U.S.Congress. (In partial or total) This should allow the miners to actually mine again without multiple federal, state and county regulations. MMAC is the only organization qualified or even close to accomplishing this.

The financial support to MMAC from the collective mining districts and miners will allow for representation at the federal level, necessary legal research, advice, GIS mapping of mining districts and all the other benefits listed above.

For everything listed, you the miner, in a MMAC Assisted Mining Districtsm, can be a part of something Big and have some major skin in the game ready to change the laws on federal lands.

Yearly dues and/or fees will be payable by January first of each year to MMAC.

CLAIM OWNER FEE SCHEDULE FOR MMAC ASSISTED MINING DISTRICTS

If you or your entity(s) are in multiple mining districts, please follow the fee schedule per year.

These fees INCLUDE YOUR STANDARD \$30.00 SILVER MMAC MEMBERSHIP

(If you already have a MMAC Membership, deduct \$30.00 from this fee schedule)

With multiple claim owners on the same claim, only one claim owner must be a Gold Member and the others must be a Silver Member.

- \$110.00 1 Mining District you are singly listed on or entity owner on a claim
- \$166.00 2 Mining Districts you are singly listed on or entity owner on a claim (15% Discount)
- \$226.00 3 Mining Districts you are singly listed on or entity owner on a claim (18% Discount)
- \$283.00 4 Mining Districts you are singly listed on or entity owner on a claim (21% Discount)
- \$330.00 5 And over Mining Districts you are singly listed on or entity owner on a claim

(25% Discount)

(Including Districts in other States)

Yearly example: You pay your MMAC Membership fee of \$30.00 per year. If you have claims in represented mining districts you are going to pay an additional \$80.00 equaling \$110.00 per year if all your claims are in **one** mining district.

(See above listed multiple mining district fee schedule for claims in multiple districts) This is totaling \$110.00 per year, <u>which</u> only amounts to \$9.17 per month for all the services MMAC provides to the best of MMAC's ability. MMAC will be adding value added services to help you the small or large scale miner get to the next level of mining.
